MHY is the first provider to bring this visionary program to Pennsylvania, and the first provider in the country to receive approval to use Medicaid funding. This groundbreaking program for children ages 9-17 yields scientifically proven results that transform lives, restore family stability and heal our youth - right in the comfort of home. And with highly trained therapists available 24/7, MHY is at the forefront of this fast, effective and groundbreaking treatment phenomenon.

MST-Psych is producing life-changing outcomes:

- Decreasing suicide attempts
- Improving family relations
- Increasing caregiver empowerment
- Improving community health
- · Reducing the need for costlier services

Back on Track

Two suicide attempts. Four hospitalizations. Overdosed on antidepressants. This was Angie's life from ages 6 to 16. Nothing was working, and her parents felt paralyzed.

When Mom called MHY for help, she learned of a new in-home treatment called Multisystemic Therapy: Psychiatric Care. As the first program of its kind in Pennsylvania, MST-Psych yields scientifically proven results that address serious behavioral problems, mental health symptoms and suicidal behavior.

After just three months of in-home treatment, Mom began to see noticeable results. "This program gave us our daughter back," she said. "Our daughter has been drug-free, has not been hospitalized and is attending school again. She is looking like a happy and healthy teen."

The Power of Family

Jessie was struggling.
Increasingly frustrated and angry, she became threatening to her family and peers. Jessie had received mental health services, but nothing was working.

When Jessie was referred to MHY's MST program, she and her family knew something was different. Abigaile Rosen, Jessie's MST therapist, equipped Jessie and her family with new communication strategies and de-escalation techniques designed to reduce conflict.

Abigaile said,

66 I helped Jessie identify coping skills to reduce her anxiety, which was found to be at the root of her anger.

Through the determination and commitment of the entire family, Jessie successfully completed her treatment and is on the path to returning to school and developing healthier friendships.



Supporting Success

Longmore Academy

MHY Family Services' **Longmore Academy** is a private academic school on a therapeutic campus setting licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education for students in grades 1-12. By providing support both educationally and emotionally, Longmore teachers and staff help students reduce stress and feel more at peace in school. Through individualized instruction and small class sizes, Longmore students feel a sense of belonging while developing impactful relationships with fellow students, teachers and staff.

Longmore is growing in response to students' educational needs:

172/34

172 students from **34 school districts** during the 2021-22 school year.



92% of students received special education services.



Over 32% of students achieved Honor Roll.



NEW IN 2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR

Life Skills Classroom: Offers a dedicated learning environment for students with intellectual disabilities. Using evidence-based practices, students engage in social and emotional learning combined with a comprehensive life skills curriculum that addresses managing finances, maintaining personal needs, growing self-confidence and exploring occupations.

Extended School Year (ESY): Available for students who meet eligibility criteria, ESY provides students with the opportunity to maintain their academic and social/emotional progress during the summer.

Through the support of the **Howard E. and Nell E. Miller Foundation**, Longmore introduced an **Independent Living and Career Readiness** (ILCR) program, providing critical life skills instruction through an evidence-based curriculum for all students in grades 1-12.

School-Based Therapy Program

MHY now provides School-Based Behavior Health (SBBH) services for **Lakeview**. Slippery Rock Area, and Sto-Rox school districts. Through SBBH, MHY clinicians provide individual and group interventions to strengthen the student and their overall environment, including:

- Enhancing interpersonal skills
- Building coping options
- Conflict resolution
- · Decision making
- · Other wellness-related elements



86% of students either met or showed progress toward their mental health goals during the 2021-22 academic year.

Autistic Support Classroom

Through the generous support of **Lincoln Learning** Solutions (LLS), Longmore Academy now offers a classroom for students with autism. The classroom features a balance between active and direct instruction, student-centered discipline, teacher language and responsibility and choice, all while maintaining a warm and supporting learning environment.

JUST LAUNCHED

MST: Problem Sexual Behavior

New in Beaver and Lawrence counties, Multisystemic Therapy: Problem Sexual Behavior (MST-PSB) is a clinical adaption of MST that focuses on the aspects of the youth's life where problematic sexual behavior exists. MST-PSB is family driven and delivered in a youth's home, school and community by clinically trained therapists.

This classroom is designed to promote an environment with predictability and stability to enhance student skill acquisition and facilitate participation in activities based on the needs of students with autism. By providing an environment that increases engagement, we foster student independence in navigating the classroom routine and everyday activities.

Nurturing Talents

Eric, 15, rarely attended school. With his father in and out of jail, this student was quickly following the same path. When his home school district offered Eric enrollment at Longmore Academy, he was hesitant but willing to try.

Eric's Longmore teaching team immediately recognized his love of music and adapted his individualized curriculum to nurture his talents, creating a learning schedule paced just for him. And when Eric's teacher took note of his morning anxiety, she suggested giving Eric a 10-minute delayed start after his fellow students were in their classrooms and the halls were calm.

In May, Eric earned his high school diploma at Longmore Academy's graduation ceremony. Despite his best efforts to look cool, he could not conceal his grin as his mother cheered from the front row!
