

hen MHY launched Multisystemic Therapy -Psychiatric Care (MST-Psych), it was the first program of its kind in the country with approved managed-care funding.

Today, we provide MST-Psych to children ages 9-17 in Beaver, Butler, Clarion, Forest and Warren counties. A scientifically proven program for children who are at risk of outof-home placement due to serious psychiatric and behavioral problems, MST-Psych transforms lives, restores family stability and heals our youth - right in the comfort of home.

And with highly trained therapists available 24/7, MHY is at the forefront of this fast, effective and groundbreaking treatment phenomenon.

MST-Psych celebrated one year of operation in Butler County in 2023.



**Redefining Care** 

The first step in helping youth and families in crisis is to stabilize the entire family. Our MST-Psych therapists do whatever it takes to help achieve that goal - from deescalating conflict between caregivers and their children to driving to families' homes in the middle of the night to respond to a crisis. Our team has redefined what psychiatric care looks like for children in our community.

**Making New Memories:** Partnership with Dutilh United Methodist Church

For many years, the congregation at Dutilh United Methodist Church has graciously funded scholarships for MHY children to attend summer camps. Their generosity continues to give kids like Jeremy a fun and impactful summer to remember.

Jeremy, 9, struggled with severe anxiety and panic. After months of intensive work with MST-Psych therapist Victoria Reich, MSW, Jeremy made significant progress in using new coping strategies to manage his fears. When Jeremy had the opportunity to attend the Jumonville Summer Camp through a scholarship from the Dutilh United Methodist Church Congregation, Victoria helped build Jeremy's confidence and manage his fearbased emotional response.

> Victoria reported that Jeremy enjoyed three event-filled days of swimming, playing and meeting new friends. He is already planning for a longer stay at camp next summer!

Rather than a program or a type of service, HFW is a process used by communities to support children and youth with complex needs and their families by developing individualized plans of care.

## **The Power of Strong Support**

School-Based Mental Health Therapy Team

As a first-grader, Oliver arrived at Longmore with significant behavioral issues. With Longmore's small class size and individualized attention, Oliver gained skills to help him effectively communicate to his teaching team what he needed. He also learned that when he was feeling overstimulated, he could ask to go to the new Sensory Room, where he enjoyed playing with the weighted stuffed animals.

Now in second grade, Oliver is one of the first students in Longmore Academy's **NEW Elementary** Autistic Support Classroom.

Oliver's mom reports that he now expresses his needs at home, and she hopes he can be a Longmore Longhorn until graduation.



#### **THE PROBLEM**

- Children with special sensory, cognitive and physical needs often face challenges in accessing traditional playgrounds and play spaces.
- · Many play areas are not designed with the needs of these children in mind. As a result, playgrounds can be overwhelming or inaccessible.
- This can lead to social isolation, decreased physical activity and increased stress levels, impacting their overall progress.

#### THE SOLUTION

- Installation of a playground specifically designed for children with specialized cognitive, emotional and physical needs.
- The playground will include features that are both traditional and sensorimotor adaptive, tailored to the needs of these children. Special features include:
  - Sensory-friendly equipment that is not overwhelming or overly stimulating
  - Opportunities for social interaction and communication
  - Space for quiet activities
  - Access to shade, water and bathroom facilities
